Volunteer Check-In Procedures:

Parking is limited:

 There will be shuttles running from UMD directly to the Super Rhubarb Festival at Stella Maris Academy Holy Rosary Campus from 10:30 AM - 3:30 PM. Park in UMD's Maroon Lot B right off of College St. and University Drive.

East 4th Street will be closed from Hawthorne Road to Wallace Avenue. Parking will be available at Ordean-East Middle School and the Holy Rosary Cathedral lot, but very limited. We have lots of people planning to come this year and we are highly encouraging people to take the shuttle. Please plan accordingly! If your shift starts before the shuttle service, we recommend arriving early to find parking. If your shift is in the afternoon, we recommend taking the shuttle because parking may fill up quickly.

Arrive 15 minutes before your shift:

- Please arrive at the Rhubarb Headquarters Booth to check in 15 minutes prior to your start time to allow for check-in, getting washed up or gloved up!
- You should plan for ample time for parking, or, if you are going to take the shuttle, you should plan on 30 minutes from the time you park in the UMD Parking Lot to the time it takes to get to the festival. Click here for more information on the shuttles running from 10:30 - 3:30
- This booth will be the first booth to the right of the main entrance to the school.
- Rhubarb Festival Volunteers will receive a t-shirt to wear during your shift so we can identify
 you.

IMPORTANT: Canceling Your Volunteer Shift:

We understand that schedules change, or other unforeseen circumstances may occur. If you are sick, please stay home. Please contact us at 310-801-8818 if you cannot come for your shift so we can get someone else placed.

Be Flexible

We are still short of volunteers for the afternoon. So, if you are able to stay and help after your shift is done, please let your area leader know. If we have cancellations, or are in need of more volunteers in some areas, we may ask you to switch to another area. If you signed up with a friend/partner/spouse, we will try to keep you together. Thank you for understanding.

What to Wear

- Please be sure to wear comfortable shoes and clothing.
- This is a rain or shine event, so be prepared for any weather it is Duluth after all!
- Please leave valuables at home or in your car. Only bring what you can safely carry with you.
 We do not have secure locations to leave a purse or computer bag unattended.

Miscellaneous:

If you have questions – our Volunteer Leaders will be wearing Bright Green T-shirts. If you have any questions, look for that color shirt.

 Some positions are really fast-paced all of the time, and some might be slow. It's hard to gauge what will happen and when. If you don't think you are providing any value (aka – bored), check in with a volunteer who has a green shirt on. We may re-assign you to a higher trafficked area.

When does the Bucket Raffle start and end?

- The Bucket raffle is inside the school in the gym.
- The Bucket raffle starts at 9 a.m. and ends at 1:15 p.m. so we can tally and announce winners.
- Tickets are \$2.00 each
- Cash or check made out to Chum; need not be present to win.

Is there a Children's Fun Run this year?

- Yes, it will be at 11:00 a.m.
- Announcements will be made from the stage, families register at the children's area, which is
 in front of the school.

Is the Event Free?

- Yes, admission to the event is free. People can make a donation if they would like.
- However, you have to pay for food, drink, and everything in the bake sale.
- Volunteers will receive a ticket for one free food item and one free drink. Free water will be available throughout the day.

Can I bring my Dog?

Dogs are allowed on leash, as long as they are well-behaved. Please be cautious as this is a
public event. Volunteers will be busy and we would encourage you to leave your pet at home,
or have a friend or family member look after them during the festival.

Cash, check or card?

- We accept all payments, we prefer cash or check.
- Checks made payable to Chum.

Is it inside or outside?

 Both. The majority of the event such as booths, food booths, coffee shop, lemonade, brats, merchandise, and the stage will be outside. The bucket raffle and the bake sale will be inside the school in the gym. Live music is outside on the big stage.

Where does the money go?

The Rhubarb Festival is Chum's biggest fundraiser of the year.

What food items are available this year?

• We will have the following menu items: rhubarb brats, pulled pork sandwiches, rhubarb burritos, hamburgers, brats, rhubarb pie, rhubarb crisp, ice cream, rhubarb lemonade

• A variety of rhubarb baked goods will also be available for purchase inside the school.
